

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF NEWBOLD LAKES COMMITTEE
FOR THURSDAY, January 21, 2016
Rt. 47 and Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, WI 54501

1. Chairperson, Jim Staskiewicz, called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. In attendance were Carla Chropkowski, Connie Muckelburg, and Bill Jaeger.
2. The draft minutes of the November 19, 2015 meeting were approved as presented with one correction.
3. Discussion and possible action on celebrating Newbold's Lakes craft show and flea market. The committee reviewed the event planning categories and who will be the leader for each.

Craft Show – Connie
Flea Market - Carla
Food Concessions – Jim
Advertising – Bill

The group went on to discuss physical layout. The craft and flea market booths should be along the edge of the paved area between Town Hall and Fire Barn but all sides of the Fire Barn must be left accessible for emergency vehicles and access lanes must be clear.

A banner to attract passers-by was discussed. The Committee has a banner used for past events and it was agreed to reuse it along with another one specific to this event with date and time. Jim will check on sources and prices for the banner. Tentatively it is scheduled for Saturday July 16th from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and be named the "Newbold Lakes Festival".

Jim will schedule use of the Town Hall for the event.

4. Discussion and possible action on making a video of each Lake Association's achievements. Committee members presented their thoughts on what to include on the video.

Connie proposed to show the activities and accomplishments of the Mildred Lake Association.

Carla reported she has had difficulty scheduling a meeting of the Rhinelander Flowage Association board members to plan their segment.

Jim thought Tom Doyle Lake should interview long time property owners to describe changes in the lake they have experienced. Jim wants Karyl Rosenberg to narrate their segment.

Bill suggested each lake association should emphasize a couple of their strong points which should be coordinated with the other lake segments to avoid repetition of a lot of detail. The group agreed and decided they should outline and sort out who will represent each topic.

Carla reported on her contact with an organizer of the Hazelhurst lake festival. They do two events. One emphasizes aquatic invasives and the other is part of a car show and Lion's Club craft show.

5. Discussion about Lake Association challenges.

The people from Lake Mildred are disappointed with the poor success of the loon nesting.

Rhineland Flowage needs more members to join the Association.

The Tom Doyle Association seems to have overcome a challenge and now has a full slate of Board Officers.

6. The member lake associations reported as follows:

7. Administrative matters. Jim reported the Town Board adopted a resolution supporting a State law to require children less than 13 years of age to wear a flotation device during boating activities.
