

Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee (NORC) Meeting

1. The NORC meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pete Cody at 4:20 PM on Thursday, February 6 at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, Rhinelander, WI 54501.
2. The meeting agenda was properly posted on all three bulletin boards in the town. The meeting postings were verified by Chairperson Cody.

Present were NORC members: Pete Cody, Braden Bayne-Allison, Kim Harron and Jackie Cody. Absent (Excused): Gail Fitzgerald and Ed Hammer.

3. December 16, 2019, minutes were moved by Jackie Cody and seconded by Kim Harron. Approved.
4. **The committee discussed and decided there would be no 2020 Winter Activity.** There continues to be activity at the park with snowshoeing, people walking the trail, walking their dogs and an occasional disc golfer. The NORA has been discovered for winter exercise.
5. **The Two Sisters Lake privy project remains unsettled.** There has been no contact from Blackwell Administration. Pete Cody will be contacting Blackwell Administration on Friday, February 7th.
6. **The tree order will include: Jack Pine, White Spruce, Balsam and White Birch. Jackie Cody made the motion to spend up to \$175 for different tree species. Seconded by Kim Harron. Approved.** The trees will be ordered from Iron Baraga Conservation District Crystal Falls, MI.
7. **Rookery Run Fall Challenge will be scheduled either September 26 or October 3.** The date to be determined by Mike Cozzens, tournament director, this week. Sponsorships will remain at \$100. Braden Bayne-Allison will be inquiring at car dealerships if any one would be interested in offering a new car for a hole-in-one at the tournament. Jackie Cody will make inquiries for a major sponsor (\$1,000+) for the tournament. Jackie and Pete Cody will contact 2019 sponsors to sponsor the 2020 tournament. The tournament hopes to increase players from 67 to 72-80 for 2020 tournament.
8. **The parking lot expansion and the designated green space recommendations will be brought to the Newbold Board for action at the February 13, 2020, meeting.**
