

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF NEWBOLD LAKES COMMITTEE
FOR THURSDAY, March 16, 2017
Rt. 47 and Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, WI 54501

1. Chairperson, Jim Staskiewicz, called the meeting to order at 4:25 pm. In attendance were Connie Muckelburg (Lake Mildred & Clear Lake Property Owners Association), and Bill Jaeger (Two Sisters Lake Association).
2. The draft minutes of the October 20, 2016 meeting were approved with one correction.
3. Discussion on any activities the lake associations had over the winter.

Tom Doyle Association is again having an “Ice Off” contest and Association member Karyl Rosenberg has nominated Oneida County Land and Water Conservationist for a science award.

Lake Mildred Association plans to stock their lake with walleyes. The Association President has been active in the Wisconsin Shoreland Initiative.

Two Sisters Lake was designated official Island Steward status by the Wi. DNR. The Association Board has revised the guidelines for shoreline AIS surveys.

4. Discussion and possible action on projects and directions the Newbold Lakes Committee will be going for 2017. Connie suggested the Rhinelander Flowage Association could use help to increase their membership numbers. Jim suggested the committee may be able to help improve boat landings that aren't owned by the Town of Newbold and there may be some things the committee could do to help property owners on lakes that don't have a formal Association.
5. Administrative matters. Connie has been updating her list of people and organizations that can be contacts regarding lake issues. Lake Committee projects for 2017 will be on the agenda for next month. The next meeting is planned for April 20th.
