

Minutes of the Town of Newbold Town Board Special Town Board Meeting Held on Monday, March 19, 2018

The Town of Newbold Town Board met on Monday, March 19, 2018 at 4:30 p.m., in open session for a Special Meeting of the Town Board, at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive and Highway 47, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501, Oneida County, Wisconsin. The following was discussed:

Chairman Kroll called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. The following were in attendance: Dave Kroll, Chairman; Bob Metropulos, Jim Staskiewicz, Ed Hammer, Mike McKenzie, Supervisors; Kim Gauthier, Clerk. Jodie Hess, Treasurer was absent and excused. The Clerk noted the agenda was properly posted in all three bulletin board locations of the town.

Discussion and action on stripping and waxing the flooring in the Town Hall. The Clerk noted after painting the interior walls of the town hall it was very apparent that the floor had not been waxed in many years and requests the board consider stripping and waxing the floor. The Clerk presented four estimates received from Clean as Can Be, Northern Clean, Right Shine and Victory Janitorial. Estimates ranged from \$803.40 to \$494.40, as presented. *A motion was made by Mr. Hammer and Mr. Metropulos to award the flooring project to Northern Clean at \$589.77, with an additional charge to be determined for the hallway and kitchen inclusion, as discussed. That motion carried on a voice vote of all ayes.*

Administrative review and action, if necessary, concerning general government, public safety, recycling, sanitation, culture, education, job assignments, project updates, transportation, budget items, fund transfers, and future agenda items. Chairman Kroll indicated he received information prior to the meeting from Attorney Kaufman that the Anderson court determination is going to an appeal. Mr. Staskiewicz requested the board discuss an RFP draft he presented for the next meeting on March 29th.

The meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m., on a motion made by Mr. Staskiewicz and Mr. McKenzie with no objection.
