

Informational Meeting of Town of Newbold held on Saturday, March 25, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. at the Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive and Hwy 47, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501. Hosted by the Town Board, discussion on the Spring Election advisory referendum question, “Should the Town of Newbold allow ATV/UTV operation on town roads?”.

The purpose of the mentioned town meeting was to provide a public informational meeting to allow open discussion and debate by Newbold electors on the subject allowing ATV/UTV operation on town roads.

There were fifty-people in attendance including the town board, media and those residents and non-residents listed on the sign-in sheet provided. There was a quorum of town board members present and the meeting notice included notice of the quorum. No decisions were made by the town board. There was discussion on the pros and cons of possibly opening all town roads to ATV/UTV use. The referendum question will be on the April 4, 2017 election ballot as a yes or no vote. This vote is advisory only and not binding. Discussion concluded at approximately 2:15 p.m.
