

Newbold Outdoor Recreation Area Committee Meeting

July 12, 2018 at 3:00 p.m.

Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, WI 54501

The Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee meeting was called to order by Pete Cody at 3:00 p.m., at the Newbold Town Hall. Present were Jackie Cody, Pete Cody, Kim Gauthier, Ed Hammer; Committee Members. The meeting notice was properly posted.

Discussion and action on approving Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee meeting minutes of June 28, 2018. *A motion was made by Mr. Hammer and Mrs. Cody to approve the NORC minutes of June 28, 2018, as presented. That motion carried on a vote of all ayes. Mrs. Gauthier abstained.*

Discussion and possible action on the following agenda items:

Commemorative Disc order discussed. A down payment of \$250 needs to be mailed to Mike Cuzzins. *A motion was made by Mr. Hammer and Mrs. Cody to approve payment on the commemorative disc order, as described. That motion carried on a vote of all ayes.* Mrs. Gauthier requested information regarding the payment details be sent to her for payment.

Discussion on sponsor kiosk dedication in the name of Wayne Wagler. Further discussion on sponsorship notation and location will take place next meeting.

Score Card options provided by Jackie Cody with preliminary work being done by Hahn Printing at a cost of \$186 per five-hundred. Informational brochure and map options include pricing of \$528 per five-hundred and \$785 per one-thousand brochures. *A motion was made by Mr. Hammer and Mrs. Gauthier to accept the brochure proposal with a quantity of 1,000 and 500 score cards from Hahn Printing, as discussed. That motion carried on a vote of all ayes.*

Outdoor recreation survey was completed and sent to NCRP by Mr. Hammer.

Grants recently received include \$500 from the United Way towards brochures and the Rhinelander Community Foundation in the amount of \$1,200 towards disc golf course signage. Mrs. Gauthier informed the committee of another grant opportunity and will submit a letter of interest to the Rhinelander Woman's Club by this Friday.

Citizen pickle ball request. No new information was submitted to the committee. No action.

Donation tube was installed at the recreation area and donated by the DNR. The metal tube will need painting and a "donation" label placed. Mrs. Cody will look into obtaining the label. Small envelopes will be purchased and a stamp with the following: "Thank you for your Donation, Town of Newbold, PO Box 1063, Rhinelander, WI 54501", will be purchased order by Mrs. Gauthier.

Interpretive signs and plant identification was begun by Mrs. Gauthier and her daughter. Identification and logging will continue through the summer and fall with work on signage over the winter, as discussed.

Disc golf course work continues. Dave Kroll has hauled top soil for several fill areas needed and spent much time working on the course in the last few weeks volunteering his time and tractor equipment. He has agreed to brush hog by the end of July. This has significantly helped the progress. Grass mats and seeding will be needed and sign posts placed in the next few weeks. Recent volunteers include Blackwell Job Corp and McNaughton Correctional. Both have done excellent work on the project. Mr. Cody provided the committee with a spreadsheet of tasks yet to accomplish.

Discussion on the need for the privy to be cleaned and toilet paper replenished on a regular cycle by the town.

It was noted that the parking lot was torn up in the last week and the Sheriff's Office was contacted. Discussion on possible parking lot bumpers to delineate parking areas and possibly prevent spin-outs. Options will be researched and discussed with the Town Chairman.

The dog waste station post needs to be placed. A volunteer is needed to help with this project.

Administrative matters for review and discussion by the NORC, including future meeting schedules, agendas and project updates. Next meeting was set for Thursday, August 2nd at 3:00 p.m.

Motion to adjourn at 4:00 p.m., by Ed Hammer and Jackie Cody with no objection by the committee.
