

## **Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee Meeting**

**September 3, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.**

1. The Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman, Pete Cody at 2:02 p.m., on September 3, 2019 at the Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501. Present were NORC members Jackie Cody, Pete Cody, Kim Harron and Kim Gauthier arrived at 2:17 p.m. Members of the public were Dave Kroll. The meeting agenda was properly posted on all three bulletin boards in the town.
2. Approval of meeting minutes. ***A motion was made by Jackie Cody and Kim Harron to approve the July 2, 2019 NORC meeting minutes as presented. That motion carried on a voice vote of all eyes.***
3. **Rookery Run Disc Golf Tournament – September 28, 2019.** Mrs. Cody indicated plans continue to come together with Mike Cuzzin, Tournament Director. Event sponsors have all come together and volunteers will be coordinated. A sponsor thank you letter was distributed to the committee and a brochure that Mrs. Cody made for the tournament bags to indicate the sponsors was also distributed. A selfie station was proposed by Mrs. Cody and the signage will be worked out with the town public works staff.
4. **Interpretive Trail Signage.** Post have been purchased and Dave Kroll agreed to help dig the holes with his tractor for sign installation. The Genesis signs have arrived and look fabulous, the Hahn Printing signs have not arrived yet.
5. **Suggestion box at NORA** have indicated very positive comments on the course and facility. The course has seen much use this summer. Donations continue and are being collected and reported to the Town Treasurer.
6. **Storage Building at NORA.** Mr. Cody indicated Blackwell Job Corp. has not given a start date to begin work. Committee agreed to an on-site cookout for the work crew with a date to be determined. The food will be purchased with NORA funds.
7. **Administrative matters.** Discussion on security cameras and surveillance at NORA, home garbage dumping problem which will be referred to the Sheriff along with a stolen camera Mr. Cody placed at NORA. Mrs. Gauthier recommended the town purchase security cameras and signage indicating the property is under surveillance. The next meeting was scheduled for September 19<sup>th</sup>.
