

## **Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee Meeting**

**September 27, 2018 at 3:00 p.m.**

**Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, WI 54501**

The Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee meeting was called to order by Pete Cody at 3:05 p.m., on September 27, 2018 at the Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, Wisconsin 54501. Present were Jackie Cody, Pete Cody, Kim Gauthier; Committee Members. Ed Hammer was absent and excused. The meeting agenda was properly posted on all three bulletin boards in the town.

Approval of September 6, 2018, meeting minutes. This item was tabled until the next meeting

Discussion and possible action on the following.

Storage garage building at the Newbold Outdoor Recreation Area was researched and presented by Jackie Cody. The proposal presented is for a 12X16 unit with supplies quoted from Argonne Lumber in the amount of \$4861.21 with an additional \$122.25 for concrete from Trapp Brothers Concrete. The proposal is for supplies only with the desire to request construction by Blackwell Job Corp. if possible, in 2019. It was also noted that there is a possible benefactor willing to donate \$1500 toward the project. *A motion was made by Jackie Cody and Kim Gauthier to submit the storage garage proposal to the town board at the next October 11<sup>th</sup> meeting for approval. That motion carried on a voice vote of all ayes.*

Discussion on possible need for a storage cabinet in the bathroom at NORA for keeping supplies.

Shirts for grand opening were discussed. Orders will be given to Hahn printing after the grand opening for long sleeve shirts as presented. Mrs. Gauthier also provided a sample of a short-sleeve t-shirt she and her daughter designed and ordered. They will be available for sale at the grand opening.

Privy locks for the bathrooms arrived and will be installed by the end of the week by the town crew.

Interpretive sign project for the trail at NORA. Pete Cody asked that notations be made for signage around basket number eleven to include white pine stumps, beaver dam remnants in the marsh between the bridges. Mrs. Gauthier will make that notation in her records.

Discussion on follow-up from survey suggestions after the NORA opener. Pete Cody noted that cleanup is completed of obstructions near basket #11; taller flags and poles installed for better basket visibility; distances of fairways were re-measured and adjustments will be made along with stickers over signage; woodchips were installed around sandy areas on fairways; garbage cans were ordered; a scheduled cleaning of toilets and picking up trash was established with the town; gates may be needed in the future to access fairway ten and eighteen in place of moving large rocks.

Donation box collection is working with two collections thus far. The opener the beginning of the month brought approximately 170 people to the course.

The Grand Opening is scheduled for the first Saturday in October with 107 responses thus far. There will be approximately 11 to 14 crocks of chili needed with town officials and committee members supplying the food and water. Jackie Cody will prepare a speaking order for the presentation and Mr. Mihalek has agreed to M.C. the event. Generators will be brought in to supply power to the audio systems and crockpots. Ed Hammer and Lloyd Gauthier will park vehicles for the event.

The committee agreed to compensate the two course designers \$100 each for their travel expenses from the southern part of the state to attend the NORA events.

Administrative review and discussion by the Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee, including future meeting schedules, agendas and project updates. Mr. Cody requested additional laminated copies of the town ordinance for NORA.

The meeting adjourned at 4:15 p.m. on a motion by Jackie Cody and Kim Gauthier, with no objections.
