

**Town of Newbold Outdoor Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes**  
**Meeting of Monday, October 10, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.**  
**Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive and Hwy 47, Rhinelander, WI 54501.**

**Those present:** Pete Cody, Jackie Cody, Kim Gauthier, Ed Hammer

**Public present:** none

1. Mr. Pete Cody, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Cody noted the agenda was properly posted.
2. Discussion and possible action on hiking, snowshoe trail, signs, DNR storm water permit, stump grinding, boardwalks, ordinances and rules for NORA, hole sponsors, signs and benches, sponsors, fundraising.
  - Signs: A list of trail signage was presented by Jackie Cody and Kim Gauthier. There is a need for approximately twenty trail signs including maps and 4X4 treated lumber posts, eight feet tall along with hardware. *A motion was made by Ed Hammer and seconded by Jackie Cody to authorize the purchase of the 4x4 posts for signage along the hiking trail. The motion was amended to include the necessary hardware for the signage. That motion carried on a vote of all ayes and zero nays.* The committee agreed to forward onto the town board for approval to spend \$500 for signs, posts and hardware.
  - DNR Permit: Ed Hammer indicated he is ready to submit the DNR storm water permit application and will need to submit payment. Mrs. Gauthier will take care of the payment required. Mr. Hammer has put over sixteen hours of volunteer work into the permit application which must be done electronically.
  - Stump Grinding: Mr. Cody indicated stump grinding began October 8<sup>th</sup> in the fairways by Jerry Roberts with Tip Top Tree service. Progress is good.
  - Boardwalks: The first boardwalk is three-fourths complete from volunteer work done on October 8, 2016. Seven volunteers worked all day on the first and largest boardwalk in the wetland area along the trail.
  - Park Rules: Discussion on the need for park rules at the recreation area to ensure all users are aware of the regulations. Rules that the committee would like addressed include hours of operation May through September, from dawn to dusk and October through April from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. to allow for snowshoeing during the winter months. Other rules discussed include no hunting, nor trapping and no glass containers in the park and no overnight camping or parking and leashed dogs permitted and under control of the owners, including clean-up.

- Sponsors & Fundraising: Mr. Cody commented on the contacts made and he will follow up with those who expressed interest but have not submitted donations. Discussion on possibly naming a hole after Mr. Martinez. No action taken and further discussion will follow.
3. Disc golf course clean-up 2016/2017: Mr. Cody reported on the great amount of clean-up completed thus far. Fairway clean-up continues into next year on numbers twelve, thirteen and fourteen. Mr. Cody has contacted McNaughton Correctional Facility to request five work days in 2017. No commitment has been made at this time.
  4. Administrative matters. The next NORC meeting was scheduled for November 28, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.
  5. Public Comment. None present.
  6. Adjournment motion made by Mrs. Gauthier and seconded by Mr. Hammer at 10:04 a.m. No objections.
