

## Minutes of the Town of Newbold Town Board Special Town Board Meeting Monday, November 18, 2019

The Town of Newbold Town Board met on Monday, November 18, 2019 at 4:00 p.m., in open and closed session for a Special Meeting of the Town Board, at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, 4608 Apperson Drive, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501, Oneida County, Wisconsin. The following was discussed:

Supervisor, Bob Metropulos called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Bob Metropulos, Jim Staskiewicz, Ed Hammer, Mike McKenzie, Supervisors; Kim Gauthier, Clerk; and Town Attorney, Greg Harrold. The Chairman, Dave Kroll and Treasurer, Jodie Hess were absent and excused. The agenda was properly posted on all three bulletin boards of the town.

*A motion was made by Mr. Hammer and Mr. Staskiewicz to direct Attorney Harrold to pursue early resolution of the dispute discussed. That motion carried on a vote of Mike McKenzie, aye; Jim Staskiewicz, aye; Ed Hammer, aye; Bob Metropulos, aye.*  
The Clerk will also contact the town insurance company.
