

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
Town of Newbold, Oneida County, Wisconsin
April 7, 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at an election to be held in the **Town of Newbold**, on **Tuesday, April 7, 2020**, in Wards 1,2,3,4, the following question will be submitted to a vote of the people:

REFERENDUM QUESTION:

"Should the Town of Newbold adopt the following resolution? Resolved, that 'We the People' of the Town of Newbold, seek to reclaim democracy from the expansion of corporate personhood rights and the corrupting influence of unlimited political contributions and spending. We stand with communities across the country to support passage of an amendment to the United States Constitution stating: 1. Only human beings are endowed with constitutional rights- not corporations, unions, non-profits or other artificial entities, and 2. Money is not speech, and therefore limiting political contributions and spending is not equivalent to limiting speech."

___ Yes or ___ No

Explanation: A 'yes' vote supports amending the United States Constitution to make clear that corporations, unions and other artificial entities do not have inalienable human right, and supports limiting spending by corporations, unions, and other artificial entities related to elections. A 'no' vote supports the position that corporations, unions, and other artificial entities have inalienable human rights, and supports unlimited spending by corporations, unions, or other artificial entities in elections.

Acceptable Photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles.
